

The Mayflower Bocawina National Park is a breathtaking natural treasure snuggled on the eastern end of the Maya Mountains, that expands 7,000 acres next to the Sittee River Forest Reserve in southern Belize. This protected area is managed with dedication and care of its buffering communities, custodians of their own backyard. Spanning in tropical evergreen broadleaf, lowland and hill forest ecosystems, this national park encompasses diverse ecosystems and biodiversity, cascading waterfalls and pristine wildlife, making it the ideal leisure and exploration for travelers looking to immerse in the natural wonders of Belize.

Explore the park through its ample outdoors activities, nature exploration and adventure. Hike the well-maintained trails leading through pristine forests, take a swim in its clear swimming hole with an astonishing 1,000ft-waterfall.
